

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the sum of three thousand dollars, part of the revenue derived from said licenses, shall be paid annually by the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to the President or other proper officer of the Inebriate Asylum, to be expended in the support of indigent persons committed to said Institution or accepted therein.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of May next.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Provided, That nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to render valid any subscription to the capital stock of said Company, or any promissory note or writing obligatory given therefor, which was obtained by fraud or any material misrepresentation as to the amount of prior subscriptions to said Railroad, or as to the amount of prior subscriptions to the capital stock of said Company.
