

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 2, line 7, strike out from the words "dispose of," to "and," in line 8.

Section 4, line 22, strike out from words "subject to," in line 22, to words "and should," in line 25.

Section 6, line 8, after word "duties," in line 8, insert "provided the said Court shall deem it unnecessary to require any further security."

Section 8, line 9, after word "office," in line 9, insert "if in the opinion of the Court the said security shall be sufficient."

Section 8, line 11, strike out all after the word "office," in line 9, to the word "and," in line 11.
