A bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for the use and benefit of the House of Reformation and Instruction for Colored Children, situated in Prince George's county, for the erection of an additional family building and other necessary shops and out-houses.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
