The Senate bill entitled an Act to change the name of the South Baltimore Chemical Works, incorporated by chapter 108, of the Act of the General Assembly of 1864, to that of the Chappell Chemical and Fertilizer Company.

Mr. Merryman, Chairman of the Committee on Agriculture, reported favorably,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 5, of chapter 381, of the Acts of 1872, so far as it relates to Prince George's county, entitled an Act to provide for the destruction of hawks and owls, and to protect a class of small birds in Prince George's, Talbot and Montgomery counties.

Which was read a second time.

Mr. McColgan, from the Committee on the Judiciary, reported without amendment,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 16, of Article 29, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Courts," sub-title "Judgments," and to amend and re-enact the same.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the devise and bequest of Catherine Hoover, late of Frederick county, deceased, to three Trustees and their successors, to be appointed by the Virginia Annual Conference of the United Brethren Church in Christ, and legalize the same.
