The bill entitled an Act to authorize the employment of convict labor on the construction and repairs of the public roads in Anne Arundel county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Deer Park, in Garrett county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to purchase and buy out the stock and interest of the Baltimore City Passenger Railway Company, together with such appurtenances belonging to said railway as the said Mayor and City Council may deem proper,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
