The bill entitled an Act to approve an Act passed January session, 1872, chapter 245, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Rail Road Company, as provided by section 54, of Article 3, of the Constitution.
