## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, strike out all after the word "provided," and insert "that no extra assessment shall be made, and no extra or special tax shall be levied or collected on any bridge or bridges over a navigable stream, forming any part of the roadway of any railroad or railroads in this State.
