

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 1, add:

“*Provided*, That the tax in Talbot and Harford counties shall be one dollar on either dogs or bitches.”

Section 8, line 2, after the word “Dorchester,” insert “Wicomico, Montgomery, Allegany and Worcester.”

Which was adopted.

Mr. Koons submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 2, strike out all after the word “to,” in line 17, to the word “*provided*,” in line 18, and insert in lieu thereof, “the creation of a fund to be used in payment of losses of sheep-owners, resulting from the destruction of sheep by dogs.”

Which was rejected.
