The Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the increase and growth of fish and terrapins in the waters of this State, with proposed amendment:

Section 3, add "Kent, Dorchester, Wicomico, St. Mary's, Charles, Harford and Caroline counties."

On motion of Mr. Stewart, of Baltimore city,

The further consideration thereof was postponed,

And said bill recommitted to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

Mr. Merryman, Chairman of the Committee on Agriculture, reported without amendments,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to promote the efficiency of the Maryland Agricultural College.

Which was considered.

Mr. Merryman moved that the said bill be ordered to a second reading this day, under the provisions of the Constitution, Article 3, section 27.
