The bill entitled an Act to provide for the protection of birds in Garrett county.

The bill entitled an Act to provide for maintaining and keeping in repair the public roads in Anne Arundel county, and to repeal the Act passed at January session, 1870, chapter 192.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Baltimore county to grant right of way through the jail lot of said county, to the Towson town Rail Road Company and the Maryland and Pennsylvania Rail Road Company.

The bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 20 of the Public Local Laws for Talbot county.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal, amend and re-enact section 94, of the Act of Assembly, chapter 294, passed January session, 1870, entitled an Act to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws for Charles county, under the head of "roads."

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to purchase, at its discretion, the property of the Western Maryland Rail Road Company, and to issue the bonds of the City of Baltimore in order to provide for the payment-money for said purchase.
