AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Line 5, section 6, strike out the words “any Justice of the
 Peace in this” and insert “the Circuit Court for Garrett.”

Line 15, section 6, after the word “days” strike out all to
 end of section.

Line 5, section 7, after the word “Peace” strike out all to
 end of section, and insert “who for probable cause shown
 shall commit the offender in the absence of proper bail to jail
 to await the action of the Grand Jury.”
