CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to confirm the bequest and devise of Benjamin Parsons, late of Wicomico county, deceased, to the Vestry of Spring Hill Parish for certain uses and purposes therein named.

WHEREAS, Benjamin Parsons, late of Wicomico ^{Preamble} county, deceased, did by his last will and testament, duly probated by the Orphan's Court of said county, and duly recorded in the office of Register of Wills of said county, devise to the Vestry of Spring Hill Parish, the lot of ground near the line of Salisbury, known as the "Parsons Lot," to be used by said Vestry as a Cemetery and for other purposes, also he did give and devise to said Vestry for the use of St. Peter's Church in Salisbury, the lot of ground in the rear and east of the Parsonage lot, also he did bequeath to said Vestry, six hundred dollars for certain uses and purposes named in his said last will and testament, therefore—

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction and consent of the ^{Sanction given to bequests of Benj Parsons.} General Assembly of Maryland, be and the same is hereby given to said devises and bequests.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take ^{In force} effect from the date of its passage.
