CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to authorize Henry C. Lay, Bishop of the Diocese of Easton, as such in the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States of America, his successors in office, and his and their assigns, to hold a lot or parcel of land conveyed to him by William Goldsborough and others, by deed dated the thirty-first day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy-three, for the uses and purposes declared in the said deed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Sanction given Maryland, That the sanction of the General Assembly to hold let of Maryland be and is hereby given to Henry C. Lay, Bishop of the Diocese of Easton, as such in the Protestant and Episcopal Church in the United States of America, his successors in office, and his, and their assigns, to hold a lot, or parcel of land, conveyed to him as Bishop, aforesaid, by William Goldsborough and others, by deed bearing date the thirty-first day of October, in the year eighteen hundred and seventythree, for the uses and purposes declared in the said deed.

Suc. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In torce effect from the date of its passage.
