

Laws, title "City of Baltimore," be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted as follows :

SECTION 872. They may extend the limits of direct taxation within the said city, from time to time as they shall deem it expedient. Limits of taxation, direct.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT supplementary to an act, entitled "an act to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county, to build a new jail in Allegany county, and for other purposes," passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter sixty-five.

WHEREAS, The amount of the bonds authorized to be issued by the act to which this is a supplement, have been issued, and the proceeds disposed of for the purposes therein prescribed; and it is found necessary to obtain therefor the further sum of ten thousand dollars, to complete and carry out the same; therefore— Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Allegany county, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, for the purpose of completing the new jail and other public property, provided for in the original act to which this is a supplement, to issue an additional number of bonds to the amount of and not exceeding ten thousand dollars in the whole, of the same denominations, to be executed, bear interest, free from taxation, and with interest coupons in the same manner and description as the bonds authorized by the original act are directed to be made. Authorized to issue bonds.
