

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section five, of chapter one hundred and seventy-three, of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, entitled an act to incorporate the "Meridith's Ford and Jarrettsville Turnpike Company" in Baltimore and Harford counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section five, of chapter one hundred and seventy-three, of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, entitled an act to incorporate the "Meridith's Ford and Jarrettsville Turnpike Company," in Baltimore and Harford counties, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows : Repealed
Amended and re-enacted.

SEC. 5. There shall be a meeting of the stockholders of said company, held at such place as the president and directors may appoint, on the second Monday of January in each and every year; where and when they shall elect in the manner prescribed in section three of this act, a president and five directors, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum; a treasurer, and such other officers as they may deem necessary for the ensuing year, and until a new election; and may by a majority of votes present, adopt, add to, alter or amend such by-laws, rules, orders and regulations as may be deemed necessary for the interest and well governing the affairs of said company, provided they continue none of the laws as mentioned in section three of this act. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force
