## CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to repeal section seventy-eight, of article fifteen, of the Code of Pubic Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Rockville," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealing and re-enacting SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section seventy-eight, of article fifteen of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Rockville," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Public building and other property of county

Appropriation.

78. The public buildings and other county property, shall continue to the uses to which the same are now allotted, the Judges of the several courts shall continue to hold their courts in the court-house as heretofore; the commissioners of the county, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables, and all other county and State officers shall have, hold, and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town, as if this charter had not been granted; and the county commissioners of Montgomery county shall appropriate annually two-thirds of the tax levied upon assessable property within the corporate limits of the town, for the improvement of the streets within the corporate limits of the town, and shall order the collector of the fourth election district of said county, to pay the same to the commissioners for the town, for that purpose.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
