Strike out all after "to," and insert "the Select Committee heretofore appointed on the same subject, and that Messrs. Denson and Stevens be added to the Committee.

Mr. Blake moved to postpone the further consideration of the order and amendment until to-morrow, and to make it the order of the day for 12 o'clock.

Which was adopted.
