CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to repeal an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal section three hundred and ten, of article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Frederick county, and re-enact the same with an amendment, and to substitute in lieu of the said act the following :

Repealed

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an act, passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter seventy-four, entitled an act to repeal section three hundred and ten, of article eleven, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Frederick county, and re-enact the same with amendments, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following is enacted as a substitute for and in lieu thereof, to be known as section three hundred and ten, of article eleven, of the said Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Frederick county."

Substitute

SEC. 310. The Sheriff of Frederick county, shall be entitled to thirty cents per day, for boarding each prisoner committed to the county jail.

In force

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after, the entrance of the Sheriff of Frederick county, to be elected at the November election, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, upon the duties of his office.
