persons, as may be duly authorized by them, and shall vote in all elections for directors in all of said companies in proportion to the stock held by them in said companies respectively.

To levy tax

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of said county, are hereby authorized and empowered to levy upon the assessable property of the county, an amount sufficient to pay for the stock so subscribed for by them.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That in accordance with the provisions of article three, section fifty-four, of To be published the Constitution of Maryland, this act shall be published for two months next before the next election for members of the House of Delegates, in the newspapers published in said county, and shall also be approved by a majority of all the members elected to each house of the General Assembly at its next session after said election.

CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT to incorporate the Mechanicstown Town Hall Company in the town of Mechanicstown, Frederick county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of

Maryland, That Charles E. Cassel, William H. Damuth, Van B. Osler, L. Randolph Waeche, and Incorporation, Henry C. Foreman, their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name and style of the Mechanicstown Town Hall Company; and by that name may have succession, and shall be capable in law and in equity to sue and be sued in the courts of this State, to make and use a common seal, and to adopt such by-laws and regulations as may be necessary to conduct the affairs of the corporation, not

repugnant to the Laws of this State, or this charter.
