CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and thirty-three, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "an act to repeal section nine, of article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the publication of county expenses, so far as the same relates to Caroline county, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter two hundred and thirty-three, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "an act to repeal section nine, of article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the publication of county expenses, so far as the same relates to Caroline county, and to re-enact the same with amendments," be and the same is hereby repealed.
