unless fully and entirely satisfied after the examination of the petition, and other investigation if necessary in their judgment, that the extra services were absolutely necessary.

In force

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and thirtythree, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "an act to repeal section nine, of article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the publication of county expenses, so far as the same relates to Caroline county, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Repealed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter two hundred and thirty-three, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled, "an act to repeal section nine, of article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the publication of county expenses, so far as the same relates to Caroline county, and to re-enact the same with amendments," be and the same is hereby repealed.
