

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT supplementary to the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter two hundred and thirteen, making an additional appropriation to Washington Cemetery in Washington county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of five thousand dollars, in addition to that appropriated by the act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of removing the dead to Washington Cemetery in Washington county, and fixing up the graves therein with proper head boards, and of enclosing, laying off, ornamenting, and completing the work already begun in said Cemetery. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the sum hereby appropriated shall be subject to the same order, and be paid out of the Treasury in the same manner that is prescribed in the tenth section of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter two hundred and thirteen, to which this is a supplement. Subject to

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force
