CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to authorize the Clerk of the County Commissioners for Somerset county to administer oaths in certain cases.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall and may be lawful for the Clerk of the County Commissioners for Somerset county, to administer the oaths, and take the probates of all public accounts presented to said Commissioners for allowance, in the same manner, and to the same effect and extent as probates are now made before justices of the peace for said county. To administer oaths.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of April next. In force

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to extend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the New York Mining Company, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-four, chapter two hundred and twenty, and the supplement thereto, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter one hundred and twenty-three; and the act to alter and amend the said original act of incorporation and supplement thereto, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter seventy," for the period of thirty years.
