CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to extend an act, entitled, "an act to incorporate the Borden Mining Company," passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter three hundred and eighteen, for the period of thirty years.

Continued in force Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act, entitled, "an act to incorporate the Borden Mining Company," passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter three hundred and eighteen, be and the same is hereby continued in full force and effect for the period of thirty years, from the tenth day of March, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly, which shall happen thereafter.
