

Misdemeanor      SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That any person, in whose possession, any dead grouse may be found, for the time for which this act extends, shall be also deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and be subject to the penalties provided for in the second section of this act.

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-five of article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Howard county," sub-title "justices of the peace and constables," and to re-enact the same with amendments so as to read as follows:

Repealing and re-enacting      SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-five of article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Howard county," sub-title "justices of the peace and constables," be, and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Justices of the peace and constables      SEC. 25. There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables for Howard county, to wit: for election district number one, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number three, four justices of the peace, and two constables; for election district number five, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number six, three justices of the peace and two constables.

In force      SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its approval by the Governor.
