SEC. 10. And be it enacted, That said commissioners Impose fines. may impose such fines, penalties and forfeitures, for breach of their ordinances as they may think proper, not exceeding five dollars for any offence, and may pass all ordinances necessary to give effect and oneration to the powers vested in them; and the President of the Board of Commissioners shall exercise the same powers as justices of the peace of the State, for the enforcement of the same.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That said commissioners may make such by-laws or ordinances, for the regul- ordinances. lation, good government, improvement and comfort of said town and the inhabitants thereof, to restrain disorders and disturbances, and prevent and remove all nuisances within said town, as to them or a majority of them may seem proper, not inconsistent with the laws of this State, and may enforce the observance thereof, under such penalties, fines and forfeitures as they shall deem proper, not exceeding five dollars for any one offence, and all such fines, penalties and forfeitures, may be recovered before any justice of the peace, by warrant, judgment and commitment to the public jail of Prince George's county, or in such place of confinement as said Board of Commissioners shall establish within the limits of said town, but the said commissioners may remit any part of such fine, or the whole thereof, in their discretion.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners may cause an assessment to be made, of all ment real and personal property within the limits of said corporation, by a party to be appointed by them, which assessment shall not exceed the present assessment for county purposes, except where improvements made thereon, increase its value to such an extent as to entitle such property to re-assessment; and the commissioners may lay a tax not exceeding thirty cents in the one hundred dollars worth of assessable property, which said taxes shall be collected by the said treasurer, who shall have power to distrain for the same, as the collector of county taxes has to distrain for county taxes, and the commissioners shall fix the compensation of said treasurer.

SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That the said commis- Appoint bailiff sioners shall have power, annually to appoint a bailiff,
