

CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT to repeal section one, of an act passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter twelve, entitled an act for the better protection of game in Montgomery county, and to amend and re-enact the same as amended.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one of the act of January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter twelve, entitled an act for the better protection of game in Montgomery county, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted

SEC. 1. *And be it enacted,* That no person shall trap, shoot, or in any manner catch, kill, maim or wound, any partridge in Montgomery county, between the fifteenth day of December, and the fifteenth day of October, nor any woodcock between the first day of January and the tenth day of June, nor any pheasant between the first day of February and the first day of September, in each year. Not to trap, shoot or kill.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
