SEC. 201. Said surveyor shall be entitled to an office in one of the public buildings of said county, to be furnished by the County Commissioners thereof, and to consist of two rooms, in one of which shall be kept the public records of said county, open at all reasonable hours to public inspection, and if said County Commissioners shall so prefer, they may instead of furnishing such office to said surveyor, levy and pay to him a sum of not less than one hundred nor more than one hundred and twenty-five dollars per annum, for office rent; provided that the said surveyor shall always keep all public records in his possession open to public inspection in said office, at all reasonable hours, and provided further, that said surveyor's office shall always be kept in the City of Cumberland.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT for the better regulation of public roads in Wicomico county.

Appoint road
supervisors

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Wicomico county be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to subdivide each or any of the election districts of the county, and to appoint a supervisor for each of the said road districts.

Work on pub-
lic roads

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all able bodied male citizens of the said county, between the ages of twenty-one and fifty years, who do not reside within the limits of an incorporated town, shall be compelled to work not less than two days in every year on the public roads in the road district in which they reside; and the road supervisor, whenever the public roads shall need repairs, shall summon all
