

CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to repeal article fourteen, section one hundred and fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title " Kent county," sub-title " justices of the peace and constables," and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article fourteen, section one hundred and fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title Kent county, sub-title justices of the peace and constables, be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted so as to read as follows : Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 114. *And be it enacted,* That there shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables in Kent county, to wit : for election district number one, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number three, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number four, three justices of the peace and two constables, and for election district number five, three justices of the peace and two constables. Justices of the Peace and Constables.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to refund to Charles G. Hanson, of Howard county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon the warrant of the Appropriation to Charles G. Hanson.
