SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 153.*

AN ACT to refund to Daniel F. Stouffer of Washington county, the sum of forty dollars paid by him into the Treasury, on or about the thirteenth day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be, and he is hereby to Daniel F authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Stouffer. authorized and directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, to pay to Daniel F. Stouffer of Washington county, the sum of forty dollars out of any unappropriated funds in the Treasury.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 154.

AN ACT supplementary to an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Ridge Passenger Railway Company," passed March twenty-second, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, chapter three hundred and thirty-one.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Supplement. Maryland, That the said Ridge Passenger Railway Company is hereby authorized and empowered to
