The House bill entitled "An Act to repeal so much of the Act passed at the January Session, 1870, chapter 434, entitled 'An Act to extend the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace in and for Dorchester, Kent, Caroline, Calvert, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Anne Arundel, Prince George's, Harford, Charles and Worcester counties, to cases of assault and battery,' and to extend the right of appeal so far only as the same relates to Kent county."

The House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Wicomico county to borrow money on the credit of the county, for the purpose of purchasing a site on which to erect a Court House and Jail, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of the county to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest thereon."
