

cipal taxation, and that the interest of said bonds shall be received by the collector in payment of county taxes.

Completion

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the remodeling, improving and enlarging said court-house, and constructing the necessary fire-proof vaults, shall be completed on or before the first day of September, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-five, at which time the said County Commissioners shall make a full, clear and explicit statement of the number and amount of bonds sold as aforesaid, give a full and detailed statement of the cost of said remodeling, improving and enlarging said court-house, and constructing the necessary fire-proof vaults therein, the name of every person to whom money was paid, and the amount thereof, in the premises; and shall publish said statement for three successive weeks, in the newspapers published in Caroline county.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to repeal section one of an act passed January session, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, chapter three hundred and twenty, entitled "an act for the protection of black bass and all other fish in the Monocacy River and its tributaries, within the limits of Frederick county," and to re-enact the said section one with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one of an act passed January session, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two,
