SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of this State, upon the warrants of the Comptroller, shall pay annually on the first Monday of July, to the Board of School Commissioners for Garrett county, the sum of twelve hundred dollars to be applied to the Public School Fund of said county, until such time as the said Board of School Commissioners shall establish a high school as provided by the General School Laws of this State, from and after which time it shall be applied to the maintenance of such high schools.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of John H. Yingling, late of the city of Westminster, deceased to the trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church of the city of Westminster, Carroll county, State of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, be, and the same is hereby given to the bequest in the last will and testament of John H. Yingling, late of Westminster, Carroll county, State of Maryland, deceased, to the Trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church of Westminster, Carroll county, Maryland, the same being one thousand dollars, for the purpose of purchasing a parsonage for the use of
