

said church and one thousand dollars to be invested by said Trustees, and the interest thereof to be appropriated annually to the salary of the minister serving said church.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to repeal section eight hundred and twenty-seven, chapter four hundred and seventy-three, of the acts of Assembly, passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to add an additional section to article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title city of Baltimore, sub-title Police, and be section eight hundred and twenty-seven of said article, and to amend and re-enact the same as amended.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section eight hundred and twenty-seven, chapter four hundred and seventy-three, of the acts of Assembly passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to add an additional section to article four of the Code of Public Local Laws title city of Baltimore, sub-title Police, and be section eight hundred and twenty-seven of said article, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted, so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-acted. .

827. Whenever any person shall be arrested, charged with any crime or misdemeanor, and carried to any of the justices of the peace of the city of Baltimore, upon whose person shall be found any pistol, dirk knife, bowie knife, sling shot, billy, brass, iron, or any other metal knuckles, razor, or any other deadly weapon whatsoever, such person shall be subject to a fine of not less than three nor more than ten Concealed weapons
