CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT supplementary to an act of November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, chapter one hundred and fifty-nine, entitled "an act for founding an university in the city or precincts of Baltimore, by the name of the University of Maryland," and to authorize the regents of the University of Maryland, to dispose of a portion of the property held by the said university for the use of its Faculty of Physic, and to apply the proceeds towards the erection of a hospital, for the use of the said faculty, and the School of Medicine under its direction.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Regents of the University of Maryland, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell, or otherwise dispose of the lot and improvements belonging to said University, situated on the south-west corner of Green and Lombard streets, in the City of Baltimore, being the building and adjacent premises now used and occupied by the Faculty of Physic of said University, for the purposes of an Infirmary, and to execute such deeds, or other conveyances, as may be necessary therefor, without liability on the part of the purchaser to see to the proper application of the purchase money.
