

of the members, while so engaged in the duties of the board, shall be allowed and paid out of the general fund.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the Secretary shall perform and superintend the work prescribed in this act, and such other duties as the board shall require; he shall also furnish to the Legislature, when in session, and to the Governor when required, such information, cognate to this act, as from time to time they may deem necessary; an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars shall be paid to him in the same manner as that of other State officers, and such necessary expenses as the Comptroller of the Treasury shall audit on presentation of an itemized account, with vouchers and the certificate of the board, shall be allowed him. Duties of the Secretary.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the expenses of the State Board of Health, including the salary of the Secretary, shall not exceed three thousand dollars a year. Expenses.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That the sum of three thousand dollars a year, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the term of two years, is hereby appropriated, from any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the objects of this act. Appropriation.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
