

CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT to approve an act passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and forty-five, entitled "an act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company, " as provided by section fifty-four of article three, of the Constitution.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and forty-five, entitled "an act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad Company," and which authorizes a subscription in the name of and for the said county, to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars, to the capital stock of the said company, upon certain terms and conditions therein specified, be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That whereas, a difference of opinion may be held in regard to the meaning and intention of the language of the ninth section of said act of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and forty-five, prescribing that certain instalments of the said bonds shall be delivered to the said company, upon the grading or completion of certain portions of the line of the said railroad lying within the limits of said county, it is hereby expressly provided, that said section shall be construed to mean and apply to the entire length of the line of said railroad, extending from the corporate limits of Baltimore city, to the boundary line between Anne Arundel and Calvert counties. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force
