

CHAPTER 235.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Charlotte Hall School, in St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of one thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the use and benefit of Charlotte Hall School, and that said appropriation shall continue for five consecutive years. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That said sum of one thousand dollars be and is hereby made payable, by the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller, to the President of the Trustees of Charlotte Hall School, on the first day of June of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, for five consecutive years from the date thereof, and no longer. Payable.

CHAPTER 236.

AN ACT supplementary to a act entitled "an act to incorporate the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the blind," passed May the nineteenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Directors of the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the blind, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to apply such portion of their endowment fund, and annual income, as they may deem expedient to establish work-shops, and to open a store for the sale of articles manufactured by the blind, and to extend the benefits of such work-shops and store, to the adult blind of this State, not resident in the institution, on such terms, and under such regulations as they may prescribe. Establish work shops.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
