SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Garrett county, be and they are hereby authorized and directed, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum of money sufficient to defray the expenses incurred under the provisions of the first section of this act.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Annapolis Savings' Institution of Annapolis city, a corporation incorporated under the General Incorporation act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter four hundred and seventy-one, and to add to the powers thereby conferred.

Deposits of
minors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That whenever any deposit shall be made by a minor who has not a guardian, in the Annapolis Savings' Institution, the Directors of said corporation are hereby authorized and empowered, at their discretion, to pay to such depositor such sum or sums as may be due him or her, and the check, receipt or acquittance of such minor shall be valid; and the deposit of a married woman shall be received and held, and paid out on precisely the same terms and conditions as those of other adult persons, any law or statute of this State to the contrary thereof, in anywise notwithstanding.
