

portions as they shall think proper; and under the penalty in the case of non-payment, of forfeiture to company of such stock and all previous payments thereon, the said assessments to be made as the by-laws of the said company may direct.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly of Maryland hereby reserve the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at its pleasure. Reserved.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to incorporate "the Harford Savings Bank of Harford county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That William Herman, Isaac Amos, E. Hall Richardson, William S. Richardson, William F. Hanna, James A. Fulton, Caleb J. Moore, Amos H. Greenfield, Frederick W. Baker, George Y. Mannadier, August Knofler and all and every other person or persons, hereafter becoming members of the corporation hereby created, in the manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be and are hereby created, constituted and made a corporation and body politic, by the name and style of "the Harford Savings Bank of Harford county," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and be capable in all law by its corporate name, to purchase, improve, lease, hold and dispose of property, real, personal and mixed; to borrow and lend money, and to make advances upon lands and buildings, and to give and receive security of whatever description for loans made to or by said corporation; to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and defend, and be answered and defended in courts of law and equity, or in any other place whatever, and to receive and Directors
