

CHAPTER 261.

AN ACT to change the place of voting in the seventh district of Wicomico county.

Preamble WHEREAS, by chapter twenty-four of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, Trappe is continued as the voting place of the seventh district of Wicomico county, the same as before the separation of said county from Somerset; and

Preamble WHEREAS, said voting place is on the extreme southern border of said district, and remote from the majority of voters; and

Preamble WHEREAS, a majority of the voters of said district have petitioned the General Assembly of Maryland to change the voting place from Trappe to Walnut tree lot nearly in the centre of said district; therefore—

Voting place changed SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the bounds of the seventh or Trappe district of Wicomico county shall remain as now constituted, and that the Walnut tree lot, at the house of James Simms, shall be the voting place of said district.

Repealed SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.
