

of any person interested; and copies of all ordinances shall be published in one newspaper of the town, or shall be put up in the most public places in the town..

Fines and forfeitures

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That all fines and forfeitures under the ordinances of said corporation shall be recoverable before a justice of the peace, as small debts are recovered.

Penalty for violating

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the sheriff of Harford county shall receive and safe keep in the jail of said county all persons who shall be committed thereto by any justice of the peace of said county, for violation of any of the ordinances of the commissioners of said town, or for the non-payment of any fine or forfeiture which may be imposed by any justice of the peace of said county for the violation of said ordinance, according to the tenor of said commitment, until discharged by due course of law, or by payment of the fine, forfeiture and costs.

Reserves

SEC. 15. And the General Assembly of Maryland reserves to itself the right to alter and amend, or repeal this act at its pleasure.

In force

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
