

Full and complete lien.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That any mortgage made by the said Baltimore, Philadelphia and New York Railroad Company to secure the payment of bonds, when properly executed and recorded in the counties of this State through which said railroad may pass, shall be a full and complete lien upon the property therein described.

Re-served

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the General Assembly of Maryland reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act or any part thereof.

In force

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to refund to Nathan O. Neighbors, late sheriff of Frederick county, the sum of forty-nine dollars and fifty-nine cents, for money overpaid by him into the Treasury.

Appropriation

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to Nathan O. Neighbors, late sheriff of Frederick county, the sum of forty-nine dollars and fifty-nine cents, being the amount overpaid by him into the Treasury on account of fines, forfeitures, &c.
