being for moneys erroneously paid by them to
Inspectors of Tobacco in Baltimore city, and amount-
ing in the aggregate to the sum of three hundred
and fifty-five dollars and ninety cents; the same to
be paid out of any moneys in the Treasury, not other-
wise appropriated, standing to the credit of the to-
bacco fund.

CHAPTER 297.

AN ACT to authorize the Trustees of the Providence Methodist Protestant Church in Carroll county, to sell and dispose of certain property therein mentioned.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church called "Providence," be and they are hereby authorized to sell at public sale, said Providence Church, situated in district number four, Carroll county, and upon the payment of the purchase money, the said Trustees shall convey by good and sufficient deed to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, the said Providence Methodist Protestant Church. ^{To sell at public sale}
