CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT to repeal section five of chapter three hundred and eighty-one, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, so far as it relates to Prince George's county, entitled "an act to provide for the destruction of hawks and owls," and to protect the class of small birds known as insectivorous birds, in Prince George's, Talbot and Montgomery counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section five of chapter three hundred and eighty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "an act to provide for the destruction of hawks and owls," and to protect the class of small birds known as insectivorous birds, in Prince George's, Talbot and Montgomery counties, so far as the same relates to Prince George's county, be and the same is hereby repealed.
