

CHAPTER 307.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section eighty-four, of chapter four hundred and eighteen, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "an act to repeal sections seventy-nine, eighty, eighty-one, eighty-two, eighty-three, eighty-four and eighty-five, of article thirty-five, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Elections," sub-title "Representatives in Congress," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, so as to make Garrett county part of the sixth congressional district.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section eighty-four, of chapter four hundred and eighteen, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "an act to repeal sections seventy-nine, eighty, eighty-one, eighty-two, eighty-three, eighty-four and eighty-five, of article thirty-five, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Elections" sub-title "Representatives in Congress," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

84. The sixth congressional district shall be composed of Allegany county, Garrett county, Washington county, Frederick county and Montgomery county, and shall be entitled to choose one representative.
