

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT to add an additional section to chapter four hundred and thirty-four, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "an act to extend the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace in and for Dorchester, Kent, Caroline, Calvert, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Anne Arundel, Prince George's, Harford, Charles and Worcester counties, to cases of assault and battery.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an additional section be and the same is hereby added to chapter four hundred and thirty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled an act to extend the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace in and for Dorchester, Kent, Caroline, Calvert, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Anne Arundel, Prince George's, Harford, Charles and Worcester counties, to cases of assault and battery, to be numbered section three, and to read as follows :

3. The several Justices of the Peace for the said counties, are hereby authorized and required to pay to the County Commissioners of said counties, every three months, all the money or moneys they may have in hand at such times arising from fines or penalties imposed under this act; and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
