Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a Turnpike Company is hereby incorporated to make a turnpike from the White House, by way of Fallston, to Magnolia, in Harford county, State of Maryland.

Capital stock

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the capital stock of said company shall not exceed twenty thousand dollars, in shares of twenty dollars each.

Subscriptions.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the subscription books for the capital stock of this company, shall be opened at Ambler and Hollingsworth's store, in Fallston, Harford county, Maryland, on or before the first day of May next, for subscriptions thereto; and that Amos Hollingsworth, Dr. Mordecai Price, James K. Keech, Capt. Zimmerman and John Jewitt, are hereby appointed commissioners to receive such subscriptions.

Organization

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That when two hundred shares of said stock shall have been taken, (including that portion of the pike already made,) the said commissioners shall give twenty days' notice, in the Bel Air papers, to meet at a time and place to be fixed by said commissioners, for the purpose of organizing said company; and the said subscribers,
