

books papers and accounts of said bank, shall be open to inspection, under such regulations as may be prescribed by law.

Deposits. SEC. 8. *And be it enacted,* That whenever any deposit shall be made by a minor, the Directors of said Bank may, at their discretion, pay to such depositor, such sum or sums, as may be due him or her, and the check, receipt or acquittance of such minor, shall be valid; and the deposits of married women, shall be received, or held and paid out on precisely the same terms and conditions as those of other adult persons; any law or statute of this State to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding:

Issue of notes. SEC. 9. *And be it enacted,* That the issue of notes usually denominated "bank notes," which it shall be lawful for the corporation to issue, shall not at any time exceed the amount of capital stock paid in; and no note shall be issued of less amount than one dollar, nor of any amount intermediate between five and ten dollars.

In force SEC. 10. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and the General Assembly reserves the right to alter or amend this act at pleasure.

CHAPTER 332.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the State Government, for the year ending thirty-first December, eighteen hundred and seventy-four.

Appropriatio . SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That for the expenditures in the support of the Government for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say:
