CHAPTER 357.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," to be known as section 871 A.

SECTION 871 A. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city may, whenever they think the public interest may require it, cause an assessment of all the property in said city, liable or subject to assessment for city or State taxes, and they may prescribe the manner in which such assessment shall be made, and provide for adjusting all differences in relation to such assessment, and do all other things necessary for making such assessment. May cause an assessment to be made.

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT supplementary to an act passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled an act to provide for the repair and improvement of the public roads in Calvert county.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That as soon as possible after the said roads are laid off in sections, as required by section two, of chapter thirty-nine, of the act of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, the said Board of Road AS SOON AS possible
